CHAPTER 306.

[Published March 24, 1874.]

AN ACT to authorize Hiram Russell to construct a dam across the Wisconsin river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Hiram Russell, his associates, successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a wing dam in the Wisconsin river, in the town of Rome, county of Adams. Said dam shall not exceed three feet in height and shall not in any way interfere with the passage of rafts of lumber, logs, boats and other crafts navigating said river without damage, delay or hindrance.

CHAPTER 307.

[Published March 14, 1874.]

AN ACT relating to incorporated companies, and to authorize the increase or decrease of directors and trustees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any incorporated company or society organized or created by general or special law of this state, is hereby authorized, by a vote of a majority of all the stockholders at a meeting specially called for that purpose, to increase or decrease the number of directors or trustees of such company: *provided*, the number shall not be less than three, and to change the time and manner of their elections from time to time, as may be deemed proper.
