CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT to amend section eight, of chapter one hundred and fifty-eight, private and local laws of 1858, entitled, "an act to incorporate the Waupaca union school-district, in the county of Waupaca."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amended.

SECTION 1. Section eight, of chapter one hundred and fifty-eight, private and local laws of 1858, entitled, "an act to incorporate the Waupaca union school-district, in the county of Waupaca," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section eight. The said union school-districts shall have the right, at their annual meeting, to raise a tax not to exceed five thousand dollars, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of supporting the schools of said district for each and every year.

Right to raise tax for school purpose.

Repealed.

SECTION 2. All acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act [shall] be in force from and after its passage.
