

CHAPTER 176.

[Published March 9, 1875.]

AN ACT to authorize the county board of supervisors of the county of Milwaukee to appropriate a certain sum to the county clerk of said county for the purpose of clerk hire.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Board of supervisors to allow a sum for employment of clerks.

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of the county of Milwaukee are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate and allow to the county clerk of said county a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars per annum, in addition to the salary now allowed him, for the term commencing the 1st Monday in January, 1875, for the purpose of enabling him to employ such clerks and assistants as may be necessary in his office during said term, said sum so allowed to be paid the said clerk in quarterly installments during said term, at the end of each and every quarter, by county orders of said county, duly issued therefor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to authorize the county board of supervisors of the county of Milwaukee to appropriate a certain sum to the county treasurer of said county for the purpose of clerk hire.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Board of supervisors to allow sum for clerk hire.

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of Milwaukee county shall appropriate and allow to the county treasurer of said county the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) per annum in addition to the salary now allowed him for the term commencing on the 1st Monday of January, 1875, for the purpose of enabling him to employ such clerks and as-
