

CHAPTER 204.

[Published March 10, 1875.]

AN ACT in relation to the police department of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The authority of the police department of the city of Milwaukee, is hereby extended so as to embrace the county of Milwaukee, and policemen of said city shall have the like authority to make arrests and serve process within the county of Milwaukee as are now possessed by them within the city of Milwaukee.

Authority of police department extended.

SECTION 2. In order to facilitate the transactions of business and performance of duty by policemen in the county of Milwaukee, beyond the limits of the city of Milwaukee, the county board of supervisors of the county of Milwaukee may supply the police department of the city of Milwaukee with sufficient authority and conveyance to travel through the county of Milwaukee.

Board of supervisors of Milwaukee county to provide authority and conveyance.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT in relation to the service of summons or process on foreign insurance companies.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any and all summons or process in any action or proceeding in any court, or hereafter to be begun or had in any court in this state, against any insurance company doing business in this state but not incorporated by or under the laws of this state, may be served on any agent or agents of any such
