

CHAPTER 310.

AN ACT to appropriate to Roby, Burke and company, phonographic reporters, the sum of two hundred and ninety-six dollars and nineteen cents.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Roby, Burke and company, phonographic reporters, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and ninety-six dollars and nineteen cents in full payment for services as such phonographic reporters, in reporting and transcribing testimony, etc., taken before the judiciary committee of the Assembly in the matter of the petition praying for the impeachment of Hon. David W. Small, judge of the circuit court of the second judicial circuit, and Jared Thompson, jr., court commissioner.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT to appropriate to John W. Brackett, Sergeant-at-Arms of the Assembly, the sum of two hundred and twenty-eight dollars and ten cents.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to John W. Brackett, Sergeant-at-Arms of the Assembly, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and twenty-eight dollars and ten cents, in full payment for travel and expenses in subpoenaing witnesses in the matter of the petition praying for the impeachment of Hon. David W. Small, judge of the circuit court of the second judicial circuit, and Jared Thompson, jr., Esq.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
