

of the county of Burnett to issue and negotiate the coupon bonds of said county to the amount of five thousand dollars, in denominations of not less than one hundred dollars each, payable ten years after date, at the county-seat of said county, with interest at ten per cent. per annum, and the proceeds or avails of said bonds to expend in the construction of a county court-house, at the town of Grantsburg.

County of Burnett may issue bonds to aid in construction of court house.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 4.

[Published February 2, 1875.]

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to the Wisconsin Institution for the Education of the Blind, for the purpose of paying and satisfying the indebtedness of said Institution, incurred by reason of the destruction of its main building, apparatus, furniture, provisions, and property, by fire.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of four thousand dollars, for the purpose of paying and satisfying the indebtedness of the Wisconsin Institution for the Education of the Blind, incurred by reason of the destruction of its main building, apparatus, furniture, bedding, provisions, and property, by fire, in April last.

Appropriation to Wis. Institute for Blind.

SECTION 2. The sum above mentioned may be immediately drawn from the treasury, and used for the purpose aforesaid.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
