

CHAPTER 128.

[Published March 31, 1876.]

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and eighty-nine (289), of the general laws of 1873, entitled "An act to amend chapter one hundred and eighty-two (182), of the general laws of 1872, entitled 'an act to authorize municipal corporations to aid in the construction of railroads.'"

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That if any of the territory of any county, city, town or village which shall have, or which may hereafter issue any bonds creating an indebtedness against such county, city, town or village, shall be stricken therefrom while such bonds shall be outstanding and unpaid, the county board of supervisors wherein such territory is situated where such bonds are issued, shall have power, and it shall be the duty of such board to annually apportion to the respective portion or portions so detached or stricken therefrom, pro rata, according to the last assessment roll of each respective year, the amount unpaid on such bonds, principal and interest, and any county, city, town or village to which such territory shall be annexed shall annually levy and collect a tax on all the taxable property within the said territory detached as shown by the last assessment roll thereof for the payment of all moneys to become due on the proportion of said bonds so apportioned, principal and interest, in addition to all other taxes and the money so raised shall be kept as a separate fund, and strictly applied for that purpose.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
