

All moneys required to be paid by insurance companies under the general laws, for the benefit of the fire department, shall hereafter be paid to the treasurer of this association for the benefit of said association. All fines paid to the city treasurer for the violation of any ordinance of said city respecting the fire department, or conduct at fires, shall, by said treasurer of said city, be paid to the treasurer of this association.

How funds to
be applied.

Section 21. All funds received by and belonging to said corporation shall first be applied, so far as necessary, to the liquidation of any just and legal claim against this said association. And after the payment of any and all such claims, said association may apply any of their funds to the relief of any such indigent or disabled firemen or their families as may be deemed worthy of assistance.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage, and all acts contravening the provisions hereof are hereby repealed, so far as they may affect this association.

CHAPTER 349.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Orphans' Association, of Milwaukee, a sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Orphans' Association, of Milwaukee, the sum of five hundred dollars, out of the general fund, for the maintenance of orphans.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
