

CHAPTER 352. .

[Published March 21, 1876.]

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to the "Fond du Lac Relief Society," for the maintenance of a Home for the Friendless.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the "Fond du Lac Relief Society," for the purpose of maintaining a Home for the Friendless, the sum of five hundred dollars, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 353.

[Published March 23, 1876.]

AN ACT for the payment of certain moneys for legal services, enforcing chapter two hundred and seventy-three, laws of 1874.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of seven thousand three hundred and eighty-six dollars and fifty cents, for the payment of legal services of counsel employed by the governor, to argue in the supreme court of the United States, at Washington, certain causes on appeal and writs of error between the state and railroad commissioners and the railroad companies, for the enforcement of chapter two hundred and seventy-three, of the laws of 1874, to be paid by the treasurer upon the warrant of the secretary of state, as follows: Thirty-one hundred and ninety-three dollars and fifty cents to L. S. Dixon, and forty-one hundred and ninety-three dollars to I. C. Sloan, in full for all services performed by them in the supreme court of the United States.
