

How affidavit  
to be made.

SECTION 2. Such affidavit shall be made before any person authorized to administer oaths, and if such affidavit be taken before any person not within the state, it shall be accompanied by a certificate of the clerk of the circuit court, or other proper certifying officers of any court of record in the county where such affidavit shall be made, in the form prescribed by chapter seventy-nine (79), of the general laws of 1864, entitled, "An act to amend chapter one hundred and thirty-seven (137), of the revised statutes, entitled, 'of evidence.'"

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 89.

[Published March 3, 1876.]

AN ACT to repeal section seven (7), of chapter one hundred and sixty-six (166), of the general laws of 1872, entitled, "An act to organize the paid fire department of any city within the State of Wisconsin, into a relief association."

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Repealed.

SECTION 1. Section seven (7), of chapter one hundred and sixty-six (166), of the general laws of 1872, entitled, "An act to organize the paid fire department of any city within the State of Wisconsin, into a relief association," is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
