

CHAPTER 94.

[Published March 8, 1876.]

AN ACT to authorize the restoration and maintenance of the waters of Brown's Lake, in the town of Burlington, Racine county, to and at their natural flow and level.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Waters may be restored to their natural level.

SECTION 1. It shall be and it is hereby declared and made lawful for the owners of lands adjoining Brown's lake, in the county of Racine, and State of Wisconsin, or any of such owners of lands, to restore the waters of said lake to to the natural flow and level thereof, and for that purpose to fill any ditch or outlet which has been dug or deepened within twenty years last past, and by means of which said waters have been reduced below the natural flow and level.

Unlawful to drain lake.

SECTION 2. It shall be and is hereby declared unlawful for any person, persons, or party, by means of any ditch or ditches, or in any manner, or by any means, to drain said lake, or lower the waters thereof below the natural flow and level.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 95.

[Published March 8, 1876.]

AN ACT relating to the Waushara County Agricultural Society, and to appropriate a sum of money therein named.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred dollars, (\$100) to the Waushara County Agricultural Society.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
