CHAPTER 241.

AN ACT to appropriate to Ira F. Killmer a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Ira F. Killmer out of any money in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five dollars, as extra pay for services as soldier in the late war, as originally contemplated by chapter 8, laws of 1861, extra session, and chapter 112, laws of 1862. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 242.

AN ACT to appropriate to A. C. Millard, H. B. Palmer and Henry C. Sibree, a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, from the general fund, out of any money not heretofore appropriated, to H. B. Palmer, the sum of \$29.53 costs, in an action, wherein the state of Wisconsin was plaintiff, and H. B. Palmer defendant. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated, from the general fund, out of any money not heretofore appropriated, to A. C. Miller, the sum of \$26.61 costs, in an Appropriation.
