

ed, however, that he shall keep such accounts, and shall at all times be subject to, and obey all orders and resolutions of the common council lawfully made in the premises, and concerning his duties, and shall report from time to time as the common council shall direct.

First election
of overseer.

SECTION 3. Immediately after the passage of this act, the common council shall elect an overseer of the poor, who shall hold his office until the next annual election of city officers, and thereafter, at each annual election of city officers, the common council shall elect with other officers, an overseer of the poor, who shall hold his office for one year, subject to removal by the common council.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 180.

AN ACT to change the boundary lines between the cities of Neenah and Menasha, in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Boundary line.

SECTION 1. The boundary line between the cities of Neenah and Menasha, on Doty Island, is hereby changed so as to run as follows, to wit: The south boundary line of the city of Menasha is hereby removed one hundred feet south of the present dividing line, commencing on the east end of Doty Island and running thence westerly to Commercial avenue on said island. And said line between said points shall be the north boundary line of the city of Neenah, and the south boundary line of the city of Menasha.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
