

repair, and shall hold the water back for the purpose of sluicing and driving said logs and timber; and when the case may require, the said gates shall be closed for that purpose.

Tolls to be lien upon logs, after expenditure of \$2,000 on dam.

SECTION 3. The tolls authorized by this act shall be a lien upon the logs and timber subject to the same, which lien may be enforced in the same manner in which other liens upon logs and timber are enforced, under the general laws of Wisconsin, or the lien laws upon logs and timber applicable to Chippewa county: *provided, however,* that the said Nicholas Abrahamson, nor his assigns, shall not be entitled to collect or receive any toll whatever until the said Abrahamson or his assigns shall have expended in building and erecting such dams, the sum of two thousand dollars, and shall have facilitated and made reasonably practicable the driving of logs and timber out of said river.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of two thousand dollars to the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation \$2,000.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, to the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society, the sum of two thousand dollars.

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of one thousand dollars to the Northern Wisconsin agricultural and mechanical association.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation \$1,000.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, to the Northern Wisconsin agricul-

tural and mechanical association, the sum of one thousand dollars.

CHAPTER 74.

AN ACT to appropriate to De Witt C. Fyler a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to De Witt C. Fyler, out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of thirty-six dollars and ninety-two cents, for money paid into the state treasury for license as hawker and peddler, for which the said De Witt C. Fyler was not liable. Appropriation
\$36.92.

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of two hundred dollars to the Columbus Union Fair Agricultural Society and the Lodi Union Agricultural Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, to the Columbus Union Fair and the Lodi Union Agricultural Societies, the sum of one hundred dollars each for the year 1878. Appropriation
\$200.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
