

the efficiency of such company as a part of the national guard; then and in such case the accounts of such company, with the certificate of the governor thereto annexed, stating that such payment and allowance has not been withheld for any of the causes hereinbefore mentioned, may be audited by the secretary of state, and when so audited shall be paid out of the state treasury to the commanding officer of such company, on such vouchers and receipts as the governor may direct; provided further, that the allowance of any such account shall not cause any greater expenditure on account of the national guard than is allowed by the provisions of this chapter in case all of its technical requirements are fully met; provided further, that application for such compensation and proof of facts upon which it is based be filed with the governor within thirty days from the date of the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

#### CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to repeal section 5 of chapter 37 of the laws of Wisconsin for the year A. D. 1881, entitled an act to change the third and fourth judicial circuits and to create the thirteenth judicial circuit, and to amend section 2424 of chapter 113 of the revised statutes of Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

When court shall be held.

SECTION 1. So much of section 2424 of chapter 113 of the revised statutes of Wisconsin as relates to the third circuit of the circuit courts of the state of Wisconsin is hereby amended to be and read as follows: Third circuit. In the county of Calumet, on the first Monday in January and the third Monday in May. In the county of Green Lake, on the third Monday in January and the first Monday in June. In the county of Winnebago, on the Monday next after the first Tuesday in April and the second Monday in November.

SECTION 2. Section 5 of chapter 37 of the laws of Wisconsin for 1881, entitled an act to change the third and fourth judicial circuits and to create the thirteenth judicial circuit is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
