## CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT to appropriate to the La Fayette County Agricultural Society a sum of money therein named.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Appropriation. La Fayette County Agricultural Society, out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the year A. D. 1881.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 14.

AN act to authorize the state superintendent to fix the amounts to be paid to the free high schools at Brodhead, Baraboo, Eau Claire and Marinette, from the general fund of the state for the year 1882.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The state superintendent is hereby Amount fixed. authorized and directed, to fix the amount to be paid to the free high schools at Brodhead, Baraboo, Eau Claire and Marinette, from the general fund of the state for the year 1882, in the same manner as provided by section 496 of the revised statutes, as amended by the laws of 1879, which sum is two hundred and ninety-one and seventy one-hundredths dollars (\$291.70) to each of said free high schools, notwithstanding the neglect of the said free high schools to make the report to said superintendent in the manner provided by section 496.

SECTION 2. When said amount to be paid to each of said free high schools shall have been so fixed by said superintendent, he shall certify the same to the secretary of state, and thereupon the said amounts shall be paid to the district treasurer of each of said schools out of the state treasury, Certificate of same.

in the manner now provided by law, the same as if said amounts had been fixed and certified by said superintendent at the same time apportionments were made to the other free high schools of this state.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eleven hundred and sixty-six and eighty one-hundredths dollars (\$1,166.80) to said free high schools, the same being the amount provided for in this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

#### CHAPTER 15.

AN ACT to authorize the common council of the city of Racine to transfer certain funds and use the same for the purpose of paying a part of the damages upon opening of Kewaunee street.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Racine are hereby authorized to transfer the sum of sixteen hundred dollars (\$1,600) from the Fourth ward house fund to the fund for opening Kewaunee street and to use the same for the purpose of paying a part of the damages awarded to the owners of lands upon the opening of said Kewaunee street in the Fourth ward.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
