

domestic, formed for the purpose of manufacturing, creating or generating any kind of power or light, to be used as a mechanical agency, when such power or light is to be used wholly, or in part, in facilitating the operations of such mining, smelting, quarrying or other mechanical or manufacturing company, or the transaction of its business.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to appropriate to the Wisconsin Dairymen's Association a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Wisconsin Dairymen's Association, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated. This appropriation is made to cover the years of 1883 and 1884, and shall be paid to said society in two annual payments of equal amounts, viz: in 1883 and 1884. Appropriation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT relating to the election of directors of the Taylor Orphan Asylum, in the county of Racine.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The male members of the board of directors of the Taylor Orphan Asylum may be elected from any part of the county of Racine, Residents of county eligible for directors.
