CHAPTER 183.

AN ACT to provide for greater economy in the purchase of supplies for state institutions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Whenever economy of expenditure can, in its judgment, be promoted thereby, materials and supplies for the use of the charitable, reformatory and penal institutions of the state, may be purchased in quantities sufficient for several or all of said institutions by the state board of supervision, or under its direction, and distributed as occasion may require. Supplies for state institutions.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts contravening with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Chippewa Falls to issue bonds for the purpose of paying its indebtedness.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Chippewa Falls, in the state of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds of said city, sufficient to pay and take up all indebtedness incurred by the building of a city hall and engine house and a school-house for said city, the judgment and bonded debt of said city, and for no other purpose. City authorized to issue bonds.

SECTION 2. Said bonds shall be issued in denominations of one hundred dollars, or some multiple thereof, not exceeding one thousand dollars, Denominations of said bonds.
