CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT to amend section 1, chapter 303, of the laws of 1882, entitled, "An act to provide for life certificates in certain cases."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 303, of the laws of 1882, is **Repealed**. hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 206.

AN ACT to amend section 4968, of chapter 303, of the revised statutes, relating to the Wisconsin Industrial School for Boys.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4968, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following: Relating to industrial school for boys. Provided, that no child shall be committed as a vagrant, or incorrigible, as in this section provided, until the supervisor of the town or superintendent of poor of the city in which such child resides shall have been notified of the arrest of such child, and permitted to appear before such judge and be heard in the matter.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
