## CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Chippewa Falls.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

Ward boundaries amended.

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 164, of the laws of Wisconsin for 1885, entitled, an act to revise the charter of Chippewa Falls, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2. The city is hereby divided into eight wards as follows: All of section 5, northeast of State street, on the north side of the Chippewa river, including the eastern additions, and all of the south half of section thirty-two, including Mansfield and McBean's addition, shall constitute and is hereby established as the first ward. That part of the territory bounded by State street on the northeast, the river on the southeast, High street on the southwest, and Columbia street on the northwest, shall constitute and is hereby established as the second ward. The mill reserve and all that territory bounded on the northeast by High street, on the southeast by River street, on the southwest by Pine street, and on the northwest by Columbia street, shall constitute and is hereby established as the third ward. All that territory bounded on the northeast by Pine street, and a continuation of the same to Willow street, on the southeast by the Chippewa river, on the west by the west line of the city, on the north and northwest by Willow street, and a continuation of the line of same to the north line of section twelve, thence on said north line to the western limits of the city, shall constitute and is hereby established as the fourth ward. Carson's addition, except blocks thirty-one and thirty-two, the south half of section one and the south half of the north half of said section in

town twenty-eight, range nine, and the south half of the northwest quarter of section six, town twenty-eight, range eight, shall constitute and is hereby established as the fifth ward. The territory bounded by High street on the northeast, Columbia street on the southeast, the west line of Allen's addition and the north and south center line of section six, on the west and Spruce street on the northwest, shall constitute and is hereby established as the sixth ward. All of the south half of section thirty-one, town twenty-nine, range eight, including the northern addition and the territory bounded by the east line of section six, of town twenty-eight, range eight, on the east, Columbia street on the southeast, High street and an extension of the same to the south line of said section thirty-one on the southwest, and south line of said section on the north, shall constitute and is hereby established as the seventh ward. All of the south half of section thirty-six, town twenty-nine, the north half of the north half of section one, town twenty-eight, range nine, the north half of the northwest quarter of section six, town twenty-eight, range eight, and the territory bounded on the northeast by High street, and an extension of a line of the same to the south line of said section thirty-one, on the southeast by Spruce street, on the west by the north and south center line of said section six, shall constitute and is hereby established as the eighth ward. And the territory between the northwesterly terminus of High street and Duncan creek shall be a part of said eighth ward. It shall be the duty of the clerk to prepare a book for use at the election in each ward, in which shall be entered, in orderly and convenient form, all lots and subdivisions of land in the ward. The descriptions shall be as platted, when the territory has been platted, otherwise, by government description. The council may require, also, that all lots and parcels of land be designated as occupied or vacant, as the case may be. The books so prepared shall be delivered to the inspectors of election for the respective wards before the polls are opened, and be returned by them with the other returns, as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2. Section 3, of subchapter 5, [relat-

ing] to the "common council and its powers," is hereby amended so that no cattle shall be allowed to run at large between the hours of nine o'clock in the evening and five o'clock in the morning.

## CHAPTER 257.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Oconomowoc, known as chapter 239, of the laws of 1879, as amended by chapter 231, of the laws of 1881, and by chapter 141, of the laws of 1882.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Section one, of  
chapter 114,  
amended.

Section 1, of chapter 141, of said laws of 1882, is amended so as to read as follows: Section 1. The amount of highway fund of any year in said city, (exclusive of poll taxes) shall be determined by resolution of the common council thereof, on or before the third Monday of November in each year, and shall be raised in money by tax on all the taxable property in said city not exceeding two mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of the property therein for that year, exclusive of all taxes raised for building or repairing bridges or approaches thereto. Chapter 7, of said chapter 239, of the laws of 1879, is amended by adding the following sections to said chapter 7: Section 9. Whenever a petition is presented to the common council of said city on or before the second Tuesday of April in any year, signed by at least a majority of all the tax payers within the boundaries set forth in said petition, along either side of one or more connected street or streets in said city, naming the street or streets, whose aggregate amount of taxable property shall exceed one-half of all such property within the bounds designated, as appears from the last assessment roll of said city, asking that said street or streets within the bounds so set forth be sprinkled with water in a
