CHAPTER 262.

AN ACT to discontinue a part of a certain state road extending into the counties of Oconto and Marinette.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That so much of that certain state road as lies between the center of section thirty-one, in township thirty, of range twenty-two, and the quarter post between sections one and twelve, township twenty-nine of range twenty-one, in said county of Marinette, be, and the same is hereby discontinued. State road discontinued.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 263.

Section 1, of chapter 218, of the laws of 1882, amendatory of chapter 100, of the laws of 1881, and amendatory of section 1570, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1.
