CHAPTER 326.

AN ACT to amend chapter 195, of the laws of 1885, entitled, An act to amend chapter 36, laws of 1882, entitled, "an act to consolidate and amend chapter 322, laws of 1880, an act to consolidate and amend an act to incorporate the city of Madison, and the acts amendatory thereof."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Amend chapter 1. of section 10, of ^{Amended.} chapter 195, of the laws of 1885, entitled an act to amend chapter 36, laws of 1882, entitled an act to consolidate and amend chapter 322, laws of 1880, an act to consolidate and amend an act to incorporate the city of Madison, and the several acts amendatory thereof, amending section 17, of chapter 7, by striking out the word, "not" after the words, "real estate," so that said section when so amended, shall read as follows:

NO PROPERTY EXEMPT FROM SPECIAL TAXES.

SECTION 17. All real estate exempt from taxation by the laws of this state shall be subject to all special taxes for the building of sidewalks, sewers and gutters, and improvement of streets in front of the same, unless otherwise ordered by the common council.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with or contravening any of the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
