CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT to amend section 3, of chapter 314, of the laws of Wisconsin, for the year 1881, entitled, "an act to appropriate the proceeds of the sale of the swamp land in Lincoln county to the extinguishment of its railroad indebtedness, and to amend sections 2 and 3, of chapter 280, of the laws of 1880."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3, of chapter 314, of the laws Law amended. of 1881, is hereby amended by inserting after the word, "loan," in the seventh line of said section, the words, "or any other loan or loans upon which said county may be indebted to said state," so that said section, when amended, shall read as follows: Section 3. The state treasurer is hereby authorized each and every year, until the said loan of said Lincoln county to the state is paid, and at the time in each and every year that the state taxes are apportioned to the different counties of the state, to credit said Lincoln county on account of the amount that shall then be due on such loan, or any other loan or loans upon which said county may be indebted to said state, and to apply on the same the amount of moneys that shall have been realized during such year, from the sale of swamp lands, situated in the said county of Lincoln, not heretofore set apart for normal school purposes, and such moneys so credited on said loan as aforesaid, shall be retained in the state treasury as portion of the trust fund thereof, and during each and every year that such credit as aforesaid, on which no moneys shall be paid to said Lincoln county, by the said state, for drainage purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
