## CHAPTER 392.

AN ACT to amend section 1, chapter 92, of the private and local laws of 1876, entitled, "An act for the preservation of duck and other wild fowl;" also to amend section 1, chapter 97, of the private and local laws of 1877, entitled, "An act to amend section 1, chapter 92, of the laws of 1876, entitled, 'An act for the preservation of duck and other wild fowl.'"

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 92, of the private and local laws of 1876, entitled, "An act for the preservation of duck and other wild fowl;" and chapter 97, of the laws of 1877, entitled, "An act to amend section 1, of chapter 97, of the private and local laws of 1877, entitled, 'An act to amend section 1, chapter 92, of the laws of 1876, entitled, an act for the preservation of ducks and other wild fowl,'" are hereby repealed

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 393.

AN ACT to detach certain territory from the town of Hutchins, Shawano county, and erect the town of Aniwa.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Town of Aniwa  
constituted.

SECTION 1. Town twenty-nine north, of range eleven east, is hereby detached from the town of Hutchins, in the county of Shawano, state of Wisconsin, and the same shall be and constitute the town of Aniwa.

SECTION 2. The said town of Aniwa is hereby created and established, with all rights, powers and privileges by law granted to and possessed by other towns of this state, and subject to all the general laws prescribed for the government of such town. Clothed with rights and power.

SECTION 3. The first election for town officers of said town of Aniwa, shall be held on the first Tuesday of May, A. D. 1885, at the school-house of school-district number 8. The electors of said town shall, at the opening of the polls, elect the clerks and inspectors of election. First election when held.

SECTION 4. The indebtedness to be apportioned to the town of Aniwa to bear the same ratio to that apportioned to each of the other towns hereinbefore mentioned, as does the assessed valuation of that portion of the town detached bear to that situated in the town from which the said territory was detached by this act, according to the last assessment rolls of said town, and the said town of Aniwa shall pay its proportion of indebtedness, ascertained as aforesaid, to the town of Hutchins, respectively. Apportionment of indebtedness.

SECTION 5. This act shall in no wise affect or invalidate the collection and return of taxes in either of said towns hereinbefore mentioned, but the same shall be collected the same as if none of the territory of said town of Hutchins had been detached and said town of Aniwa erected. Collection and return of taxes.

SECTION 6. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
