CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the persons therein named, for expenses incurred as legislative visiting committee to state institutions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for expenses incurred as visiting committee of the legislature for 1885, to state institutions, the sum of three hundred dollars, to William T. Parry, Pliny Norcross and Andrew Haben, one hundred dollars each.
