CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT to provide for the exemption of the property of the Milwaukee Industrial Exposition association from taxation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The property of the Milwaukee Industrial Exposition association, located on the public square between Cedar and State streets and Fifth and Sixth streets, in the Second ward of the city of Milwaukee, is hereby exempted from taxation; provided, that if at any annual meeting or other meeting of the stockholders a dividend or division of profits be ordered or agreed to, that the property before described shall be assessed and the taxes levied for the year following as other taxes are levied.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
