## CHAPTER 267.

AN ACT to amend subdivision 2, of section 3536, of chapter 152, of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin, entitled, "of the foreclosure of mortgages by advertisement."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amending subdivision 2, section 3536, R. S.

SECTION 1. Subdivision 2, of section 3536, of chapter 152, of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin, entitled, "of the foreclosure of mortgages by advertisement," is hereby amended by adding to said subdivision the following: Providing, that in case of the death, or other disability, of the person who acted as auctioneer at such sale, before making such affidavit, the same may be made by any person having knowledge of the facts, who shall state in such affidavit the fact of such death or other disability, and that such affidavit is made for that reason.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 268.

AN ACT relating to chattel mortgages upon exempt personal property, and amendatory of chapter 218, of the laws of 1885.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Chattel mortgage to be signed by wife, and witnessed by two witnesses.

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 218, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended so that said section shall read as follows: Section 1. Nor shall a chattel mortgage of personal property, which is
