CHAPTER 402.

AN ACT to amend section 2424, of chapter 113, of the revised statutes, entitled, "of courts of record," chapter 43, of the laws of 1879, and chapter 17, of the laws of 1885.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 43, of the laws of 1879, and chapter 17, of the laws of 1885, and so much of section 2424, of chapter 113, of the revised statutes as relates to the fifth circuit of the circuit courts of the state of Wisconsin, is amended so as to read as follows: Fifth circuit. In the county of Grant on the third Tuesday in February and the second Tuesday in October. In the county of Iowa on the fourth Tuesday in March and the last Tuesday in September. In the county of La Fayette on the Third Tuesday in June, and the first Tuesday in December. In the county of Richland, on the second Tuesday in April, and the second Tuesday in September. In the county of Crawford on the fourth Tuesday in May, and the second Tuesday in November. Every term in each of said counties shall be a special term for the whole circuit.
