CHAPTER 552.

AN ACT to provide for a more efficient service of process on railroad corporations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision 6, of section 2637, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the word, "state," at the end of the subdivision, and inserting in lieu thereof the following; "county in which such action is brought;" and in case neither of the officers named reside and are within such county, then to any station, freight or ticket agent thereof who shall reside and be within said county. 6. If against a railroad corporation whose general office is within this state, to the president, secretary, superintendent, general manager, or general solicitor thereof, if either shall reside and be within the county in which such action is brought; and in case neither of the officers named reside and are in such county, then to any station, freight or ticket agent thereof who shall reside and be within such county.

Amending subdivision 6, section 2637, R. S., — service of process on railroad corporations.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
