## CHAPTER 126.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 367, of the private and local laws of 1871, entitled, "An act to authorize the town of Grand Rapids, in the county of Wood, to keep an office and hold elections within the limits of the city of Grand Rapids," is hereby repealed.

Repealing ch. 367, private and local laws 1871, relating to elections in town of Grand Rapids.

## CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT authorizing the exclusion of certain persons from the trial of causes of a scandalous or obscene nature.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That when, in any court, a cause of a scandalous or obscene nature is on trial, the presiding judge or justice may, in his discretion,
