

same manner as decrees and judgments of said circuit courts, but in separate volumes, any decree or judgment of said United States courts, duly certified by the clerk thereof, upon payment of the same fees allowed by law for like services in said circuit court.

SECTION 3. This act to take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT to discontinue a portion of a state road heretofore laid in Monroe county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That so much of a state road heretofore laid in Monroe county, Wisconsin, and described as follows: Commencing forty rods south of the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of section number thirty, in township number nineteen north, of range number four west, running thence nearly north through said northeast quarter; also through the east half of section number nineteen; also through the southeast quarter of section number eighteen, terminating at or near the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section number eighteen, in township number nineteen north, of range number four west, in said county of Monroe, be and the same is hereby discontinued.

Discontinuing portion of state road, Monroe county.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
