CHAPTER 149.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 242, of the private and local laws of 1857, entitled, "An act to incorporate the fire department of the city of Janesville," and all acts amendatory thereof.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeal of ch. 242, private and local laws 1857.

Officers of fire department to turn over books, etc., to city clerk and treasurer of fire police company.

SECTION 1. Chapter 242, of the private and local laws of 1857, and all acts amendatory thereof, including chapter 50, of the private and local laws of 1858, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Upon the passage and publication of this act, the several officers of the fire department of the city of Janesville shall turn over to the city clerk of said city all books and papers to be kept as city records, and all money to the treasurer of the Janesville fire police company, to be used towards the purchase of a patrol wagon and other appliances for the said fire patrol company.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
