## CHAPTER 196.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Michael Bink, as justice of the peace.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The official acts of Michael Bink, of the town of Belgium, Ozaukee county, Wisconsin, as a justice of the peace in and for the years 1886 and 1887, in and for the county of Ozaukee, are hereby declared to be as valid in all respects as if he had filed his oath of office together with his official bond, duly approved by the chairman of the town of Belgium, Ozaukee county, Wisconsin, with the clerk of the circuit court of Ozaukee county, Wisconsin, within the time and as is required by law.

Legalizing acts of Michael Bink, justice of the peace.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
