CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT relating to the change of venue in the county court of Winnebago county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Change of place of trial Winnebago county court, how made.

SECTION 1. Whenever the place of trial in any civil or criminal action or proceedings in the county court of Winnebago county, Wisconsin, shall be changed on account of the prejudice or other disqualification of the judge thereof, it shall be changed to the circuit court of said Winnebago county, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. Whenever an order is made so changing the place of trial of any such action or proceedings to said circuit court, such order in itself shall be a change and transfer thereof, and of all the papers, records, and files thereof and therein to said circuit court, without any certificate or further act whatever.

SECTION 3. Section 2467, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin and any acts amendatory thereof, shall not apply to or include the county court of said Winnebago county, but is hereby repealed so far as it includes and applies to said county court, and conflicts with the provisions of this act and no farther.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
