CHAPTER 282.

AN ACT to provide for increasing the facilities of the department of mechanic arts, of the state university, and to establish courses in railway and electrical engineering there; and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. To provide for needed additional facilities, for instruction in the department of mechanic arts, of the state university, and for the establishment of courses of instruction in railway and electrical engineering therein, there is hereby annually appropriated to the university fund income one per cent. of the funds derived by the state from the license tax upon railroad companies, railway car companies, or other transportation companies, and upon telegraph companies, telephone companies and other electrical companies.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
