

said cities are hereby authorized to levy such tax annually as may be necessary upon the taxable property therein for the purpose of repairing and maintaining said bridge, such tax to be in the proportion hereinbefore mentioned.

May levy tax for repairs.

SECTION 9. All the provisions of law in relation to bridges between towns and cities, not inconsistent with the provisions of this act, shall be deemed and held to apply to the bridge herein authorized to be built.

Bridge laws to apply.

SECTION 10. All such parts of said chapter one hundred and seventy-eight, of the private and local laws of eighteen hundred sixty-five, as are inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Repealed.

SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

### CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to amend section 1084, of the revised statutes, relating to tax rolls.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1084, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding to the end of said section the following: The county clerk shall have power to extend the time for the collection of the taxes in any tax roll made by him or his predecessor in office for the time, in the manner and with like effect as is provided in sections 1108 and 1109 of the revised statutes.

Amending section 1084 R. S., county clerk may extend time for collecting taxes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
