## CHAPTER 344.

AN ACT to amend section 2, of chapter 157, of the laws of 1887, entitled, "An act to protect butter and cheese manufacturers."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 157, of the laws of 1887, is hereby amended by striking out the words, "by a disinterested competent person," in the second and third lines of said section, and all the words in said section after the word, analysis, in the fifth line thereof, so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 2. Proof of adulterations and skimming may be made with such standard tests and lactometers as are used to determine the quality of milk, or by chemical analysis.
