SECTION 4. The term of office of the city attorney of the city of Milwaukee shall be four years, and the term of the present incumbent of that office is hereby extended to the third Tuesday in April, 1892.

Repealed.

SECTION 5. All acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby modified, superseded or repealed to the extent that the true intent of this act may be carried into effect.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT to amend chapter 196, of the laws of 1885, relating to the charter of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment to
chapter 196,
laws of 1885.

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 196, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended by striking out at the end thereof the words, "eighteen hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "twenty-four hundred dollars."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the fifteenth day of April, 1889.
