CHAPTER 373.

AN ACT to amend chapter 22, of the laws of 1887, entitled, "an act to amend chapter 258, of the laws of 1883," entitled, "an act to provide for the annual publication of a railroad map, and appropriating money therefor."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 22, of the laws of 1887, amendatory of chapter 258, of the laws of 1883, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1. There shall be published annually, under the supervision of the railroad commissioner, ten thousand copies of the railroad map of Wisconsin, of which five thousand copies shall be mounted on muslin and provided with rollers, to be distributed by the state superintendent of public instruction among the schools of the state, two thousand copies shall be likewise mounted on muslin and provided with rollers, to be apportioned and delivered to the members of the legislature, and the remaining three thousand copies shall be unmounted and distributed by the railroad commissioner; and a sum of money sufficient to carry out the provisions of this act is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force at once after its passage and publication.
