CHAPTER 434.

AN ACT for an act giving consent to the United States to locate, construct and maintain a levee in Columbia county, Wisconsin, and to authorize local authorities to acquire and convey lands for said purpose.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The consent of the state of Wisconsin is hereby given to the United States to locate, construct and maintain a levee from the canal in the city of Portage, in Columbia county, to such point in the town of Pacific, in said county, as it may deem necessary, and to acquire such lands as may be needed for the construction and maintenance thereof.

U. S. may locate and construct levee in city of Portage.

SECTION 2. The city and town authorities of the city of Portage and town of Pacific, in the county of Columbia, are hereby empowered to acquire title to such lands, as may be necessary, for the right of way for the levee mentioned in the foregoing section, and convey the same or any lands owned by said city or town, including those used for highway purposes, to the United States for the purpose of said levee.

May acquire title to lands.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
