CHAPTER 483.

AN ACT to amend section 225, chapter 15, of the revised statutes, entitled, "preemption and sale of public lands."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending section 225, R. S.

Redemption, when to be made.

Surplus to go to original purchaser.

SECTION 1. Section 225, of chapter 15, of the revised statutes, entitled, "preemption and sale of the public lands," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 225. At any time before five days next preceding the re-sale of such land, the payments of the sum due with interest, and all taxes returned to said commissioners and unpaid, and all costs occasioned by the delay, together with three per cent. damages on the whole sum owing to such land, shall prevent such re-sale and revive the original contract; and if on a re-sale of such land, the same shall produce more than sufficient to pay the sum owing therefor, with interest, taxes and costs, and three per cent. damages on the amount of purchase money unpaid, the residue, when collected, shall be paid over to the former purchaser or his legal representatives.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
