## CHAPTER 503.

AN ACT fixing the terms of the circuit court for Iowa county, in the Fifth Judicial Circuit.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The terms of the circuit court for Iowa county shall hereafter be held on the fourth Monday in March, and last Monday in September of each year.

Terms of court in Iowa county—5th circuit.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to A. Hilker, William Hilker, John F. Wadewitz and F. Hamerssen, constituting the copartnership firm of Hilker Bros. & Co., of Racine, Wisconsin, two thousand eight hundred and fifty-two dollars; to Casper M. Sanger, Henry H. Rockwell, C. H. Moss, Charles A. Radcliffe and George Donald, constituting the copartnership firm of Sanger, Rockwell & Co., of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, the sum of two thousand one hundred thirty-five dollars and eighty-two cents; to Joseph Hadfield, Abram H. Hadfield and George A. Hadfield, constituting the copartnership known as

Appropriation to A. Hilker et al., for materials furnished and labor performed on erection and completion of university buildings.
