# LAWS OF WISCONSIN, 1891.

## CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to amend chapter 54, of the laws of 1885, entitled, "An act to incorporate the city of Viroqua."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby enacted a new section to be known as subdivision 35th, of section 32a, of chapter 54 of the laws of 1885, which shall read as follows: The common council, for the purpose of guarding against the calamity of fire, shall have the power to prescribe the limits within which wooden buildings, or buildings of other materials that shall not be considered fire-proof, shall not be erected or repaired, and to direct that all and any buildings within the limits prescribed shall be made and constructed of fire-proof materials, and to prohibit the repairing of wooden buildings within the fire limits, when the same shall have been damaged to the extent of fifty per cent. of the value thereof, and to prescribe the manner of ascertaining such damages.

Common council to define fire limits.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
