CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT to provide for the times of holding the general terms of the circuit court for the Sixth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Circuit court,
sixth circuit.

SECTION 1. The general terms of the circuit court in the several counties in the Sixth judicial circuit shall be held as follows:

Clark county.

In the county of Clark, on the second Monday in June and the second Monday in December.

Jackson
county.

In the county of Jackson, on the third Monday in March and the third Monday of September.

La Crosse
county.

In the county of La Crosse, on the second Monday of May and the second Monday of November.

Monroe county.

In the county of Monroe, on the first Wednesday after the first Tuesday in April and the first Monday in October.

Trempealeau
county.

In the county of Trempealeau, on the first Monday of March and the first Monday of September.

Vernon county.

In the county of Vernon, on the fourth Monday in April and the third Monday in October.

Each general
term in the sev-
eral counties to
be a special
term for the
whole circuit.

SECTION 2. Every general term in the several counties of said circuit shall be also a special term for the whole circuit.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
