CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Menomonie to appropriate a sum of money.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for the common council of the city of Menomonie, to appropriate a sum of money not to exceed three hundred and fifty-eight dollars, in payment of the indebtedness due and unpaid upon the bridge built across the Red Cedar river, near Irvine creek, in the town of Menomonie.

Common council may pay for bridge across Red Cedar river.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
