CHAPTER 191.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 21, of the laws of 1885, entitled, "An act to amend section 1, of chapter 237, laws of 1883, relating to the establishment and maintenance of public watering places."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 21, of the laws of 1885, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "And provided further, that every such tank or trough shall be at least six feet in length and not less than ten inches in width, and shall be securely placed at least two and one-half feet above the surface of the highway." Amends chapter 21, laws of 1885.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 6, 1891.

CHAPTER 192.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Cement land company, its successors or assigns, to construct and maintain one or more piers, docks or wharves into Lake Michigan, in Milwaukee county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Cement land company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Wisconsin, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain one or more piers, docks or wharves extending into Lake Michigan from or Cement Land Company authorized to construct piers, docks and wharves in Lake Michigan in Milwaukee county.
