

quires it. The said agent, while acting as such, shall be paid his necessary traveling expenses, in the same manner as other bills against said state public schools are allowed and paid by the state board of supervision.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 260.

AN ACT to repeal section 5, of chapter 512, of the laws of 1870, entitled, "An act to amend chapter 232, of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled, 'An act to incorporate the Oshkosh & Mississippi River Railroad Co.'"

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeals section
5 of chapter
512, laws of
1870.

SECTION 1. Section 5. of chapter 512, of the laws of 1870, entitled, "An act to amend chapter 232, of the private and local laws of 1866, entitled, 'An act to incorporate the Oshkosh and Mississippi River Railroad company,'" is hereby repealed.
