CHAPTER 286.

AN ACT to provide what shall be due proof of the service of notices and other papers authorized or required by law to be served.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amends section 4173, revised statutes 1878

Proof of service of notice, etc.

SECTION 1. The revised statutes of 1878, are hereby amended by adding after section 4173, a new section to be known as section "4173a," which shall read as follows: Section 4173a. Whenever any notice or other writing is by law authorized or required to be served, the affidavit of the person serving it, setting forth the facts necessary to show that it was duly served, shall be presumptive proof that such notice or writing was duly served. But this act shall not apply to any service where another way of proving service is expressly prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
