CHAPTER 301.

AN ACT relating to the appointment and salaries of under sheriff and deputy sheriffs in Milwaukee county, and to amend section 2, of laws of 1877, as amended by chapter 207, of the laws of 1882.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2, of chapter 227, of the laws of 1877, as amended by chapter 207, of the laws of 1882, is hereby further amended by striking out the word "nine" wherever it occurs in said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifteen," so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 2. Said sheriff is hereby authorized to appoint one under sheriff who shall receive a salary of fifteen hundred dollars per annum, to be paid monthly out of the treasury of Milwaukee county, and fifteen deputy sheriffs, of whom one shall act as clerk in the sheriff's office; the said deputy sheriffs shall receive a salary of one thousand dollars per annum, except the one acting as clerk in the sheriff's office, under the provisions of this act, who shall receive a salary of twelve hundred dollars per annum. One of such deputies shall be assigned to the office of the district attorney of Milwaukee county, and shall be subject to the orders of the district attorney. The salaries of said fifteen deputy sheriffs shall be paid monthly out of the treasury of said Milwaukee county, and the salaries so paid to said under sheriff and said deputy sheriffs shall be in lieu of all fees, per diem, and other emoluments of whatever kind or nature heretofore allowed by law.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts, in so far as they conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
