CHAPTER 336.

AN ACT relating to courts of record and to amend section 2426, revised statutes of 1878.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amends section 2426, revised statutes 1878

Extra terms, not exceeding two, may be held in each county, jurors may be summoned.

SECTION 1. Section 2426, revised statutes, 1878, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The judge of any circuit court may by an order entered and recorded in the clerk's office, appoint not to exceed two extra terms of court to be held in any county in his circuit when he shall deem it necessary during any one year, and may or may not, in his discretion, cause jurors therefor to be drawn and summoned as for other terms. At such extra terms the same business may be transacted as at a regular term for such county.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.
